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TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR DIGITAL LIFELINE ALARM SUPPORT

This grant is provided at the discretion of the Trustees of the Stoke Mandeville and Other Parishes Charity

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

It is important that you understand that this grant is NOT from the Parish Council and is given at the discretion of the Trustees of the Charity, not as a right of residency.

As a charitable grant, your maintenance grant will be reviewed annually by the Trustees of the Charity and will only be renewed annually if the Trustees deem there to be sufficient Charity funds available to provide the support, and if they agree that continuing this support is the best use of Charity funds.

You must be aware that, although unlikely, this grant could cease at any point.

What is this grant for?

This grant is a contribution toward the costs of installation and maintenance of a digital lifeline alarm. If you do not require a digital version of the lifeline alarm, please contact Mrs Dobson for a standard lifeline alarm application form.

This grant is financial support only. The Charity cannot arrange the installation of your alarm and is not responsible for any physical maintenance of your alarm. Do not submit your application for this grant before you have installed your digital alarm.

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TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR DIGITAL LIFELINE ALARM SUPPORT

Who can apply for this grant

This grant is available to residents of the parish of Stoke Mandeville who have lived in their Parish for 2 or more years.

How to apply for this grant

To apply for this grant please complete the application form and send it to the address above with proof of installation of your digital lifeline alarm.

What happens next?

If your application is successful, the Trustees will award a one off payment of **£80** toward installation of your digital alarm, and up to **£147** annually toward your maintenance costs.

You will receive your grants in lump sum by cheque, and it will be up to you to budget for your regular maintenance payments to the alarm facilitator.

Please be aware: Your first year of maintenance grant will not be the full annual award unless you have applied in January. Year one of maintenance will be pro-rated for the month your application was submitted.

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TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR DIGITAL LIFELINE ALARM SUPPORT

Continuing your support

The sums granted will be reviewed annually and set in-line with the amounts awarded to non-digital lifeline alarm users also supported by the Charity.

You are only required to apply for the annual maintenance once. After the first year, you will automatically be sent a cheque for your annual maintenance in January.

If you no longer require alarm support, you are obliged to contact the Charity as soon as possible to stop your annual grant payments.
